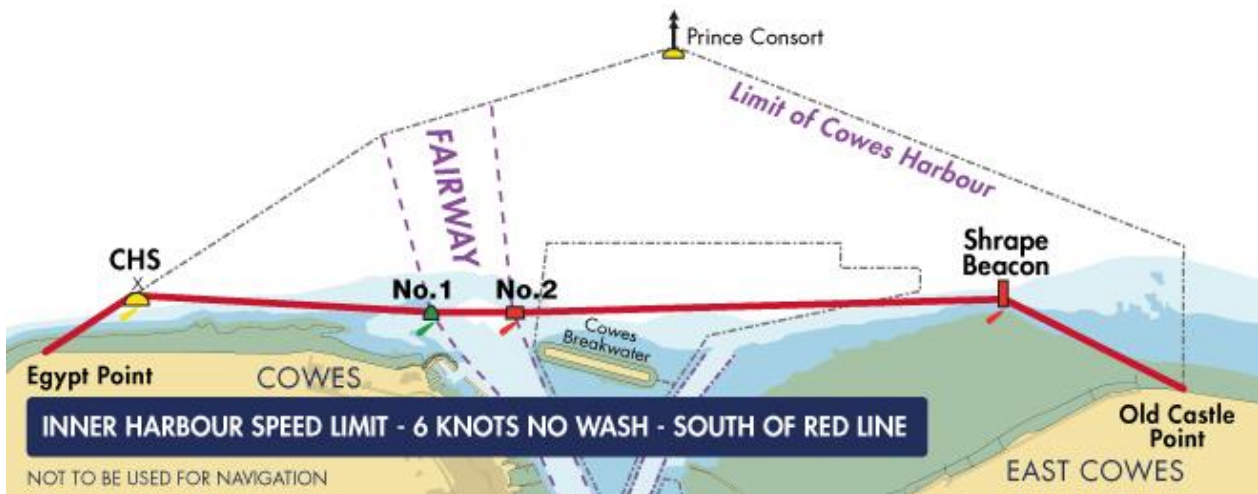
LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 22(T) of 2020 CHS Special Mark Repositioned

(This notice replaces Local Notice to Mariners 21(T) of 2020, which is hereby cancelled)

Notice is hereby given that the CHS special mark has been moved to a new position and an unnamed special mark has been substituted in its place.

The CHS special mark is now in position approximate **50° 46.'09 N 001° 18'.70 W** and retains all of its existing characteristics (i.e. a yellow, round mark with a single yellow cross top mark, and showing light characteristic Fl.Y.4s).

The reason for this buoy move is to provide a **visual indication** to harbour users of the northwestern limit of the Inner Harbour "**6 knots speed limit and no wash**" area as shown in the diagram below:



The unnamed special mark (in the position vacated by the CHS special mark) is a yellow, round mark without a top mark, and showing light characteristic Fl.Y.4s.

This Local Notice to Mariners shall remain in force until further notice.
